

## Signals by Day

When I would have all Captains Assemble on board the Chester  
I will spread abroad an English Ensign in the Mizzen Shrouds  
with the Coular flying, one Gun for all Lieutenant the same  
Ensign in the Mizzen Shrouds with a whoop in the Ensign  
Hoisted Staff up one Gun When I would have the fleet close  
in their Stations under my Stern I will Hoist a French Jack  
at the foretopmast Head one Gun When I would have the  
Squadron spread and sail a two cables length a sun down from  
each other I will Hoist an English Jack at the Foretopmast  
Head and fire two Guns When I would have the Squadron  
Jack all together I will Hoist a Chequered Jack at the foretop-  
mast Head and fire one Gun When I would have the Headmost  
and weathermost ship Jack first I will hoist a yellow flagg  
at the foretopmast Head and fire one Gun When I would have the  
Stoornmost and Leewardmost ship Jack first I will Hoist a red  
flagg at the foretopmast Head and fire one Gun When I would  
have the fleet wear and sail on the other Jack I will Hoist  
a blue woods Jack at the foretopmast Head and fire two Guns  
When I would have the Squadron bring too on the Starboard  
Jack I will Hoist an English Ensign at the Mizzen Topmast  
Head and fire one Gun If on the Larboard Jack two Guns  
To make sail after laying by the same flagg, three Guns  
When I would have the fleet Anchor I will Hoist a Chequered  
flagg at the Mizzen Topmast Head and fire one Gun The order  
of sailing The Chester the two Schooners one on each Quarter, the  
Plato on my Starboard Quarter without the Schooners. The Amelia  
on the <sup>Larboard</sup> Quarter without the Schooners and the Conqueror a Stern  
of all.
