- 24 *Wed.* We parted at Mr. Handerson's, he to Phila., & I home: where I arrived that day.

 Mr. Lewis arriv'd here, by whom Mr. Leonard's death: died 28th Oct'r 1764.
- 21 *Wed.* D'o (i.e. Mr. Lewis) returned.
- 30 *Fri.* We killed our Hogs, in number 23.
 Christened Henry Curry(?) Godparents: James _____ & Rachael Seth.
