 11 *Tues.* Mr. Doyna went home.  
 13 *Thurs.* Mr. Naile return'd.  
 28 *hi.* From Wye, I wrote to Mr. Hunter about ye Land, to be bought near Queen's-Town.  
 29 *Sat.* Christened John Sayer Blake. Godparent: Theodore Wetherstrand.

- JANUARY 4 *hi.* We killed 6 Hogs..

 31 *Thurs.* Molly's child, Joe; was found dead with Rachael, in Bed.
- FEBRUARY 3 *Sun.* A Letter sent from Bohemia to Mr. Hall to engage ye Land, near Queen's Town.

 10  
 17 9 *Sat.* Hung up to be smoked 32 Gammons, & 36 Shoulders & Midlings. We had ye 1st Lamb.

- MARCH 11 *Mon.* I received of Mr. Manners, to pay 260:10:0 for our Land in Talbot.  
 3  
 10 Received of Mr. Harding as a Gift: 7:0:0.  
 17  
 24 17 *Sun.* Married Paul and Rebecca, negroes of Mr. FitzSimmons; as also, Daniel and Rachael, ye man, Mr. Tuite's, ye woman Phil. Green's. Testes to both: Many of Mr. Tuites' negroes.  
 31
- \* 18 *Mon.* I took possession of a Tract of Land I bought of Parson Miller & his wife & Sarah Millington: on which I put <sup>8</sup> negroes, which I brought from Mr. Lewis then living at ye White Marsh. Viz: Nanny, Tom, Fran, Lucy, Davy, Nancy, Paul, & Henny.  
 Their expenses in transporting & present Provisions came to.....10:0:00 viz: corn from Mr. Tuite 9L, etc.  
 For plank of Chas. Seth 2:0:00.
- The names of ye 8 negroes that came from ye Marsh to St. Joseph's on the Head of Wye in Talbot County, Maryland, 1765.  
 1st. Nanny.....Guinea negroe.....age 55  
 2'd Tom.....born Jan'y 2, 1737.....age 28
