- 15 *Sun* Married Isaac Jackson and Polly Poth by license at St. Joseph's. Witness: Billy Councill, Sam Jackson, and others.
- 25 *Wed* Buried, Old Tom Denby, at Chas. Blake's, Corsica.  
Buried, Ann \_\_\_\_\_, an old negro, same place.  
Buried four children - same place.  
Buried Old Mary, a free negro, at Brown's place.
- 29 *Sun* Married Luther Martin's Tom, to Mrs. Browning's Ldd, by note. Present, negro Sam Henry, at St. Joseph's.
- FEBRUARY 18 *Sat* Married James Blunt's negroes, Charles and Mary, by note, at St. Joseph's. Old Tom present, and others.
- 19 *Sun* Married the following negroes: Doctor Davidson's Ben to John Cedar's wench, Henny. Mr. Aaron's man, Andrew to Mr. Ford's woman, Grace, at Crabbin's place, by note. Many present.
