- DECEMBER** 3 *Sun.* Married, 2 negroes of Mrs. Wilson's, by note, at Mr. Crabbin's place.
- 18 *Mon.* Buried, Fanny, our negro.

- JANUARY** 6 *Sat.* Married James Corkrall and Rachel Willoughby by license. Test: Bradb. Corkrell, Elisha Tyler, Jos. Callahan, and others.
- FEBRUARY** 25 *Sun.* Married, negro Sam of Solomon Scott's to Rachel, ye property of Sally Councell, at Counsel's, with a note.
- MARCH** 6 *Tues.* "Christened Maria, daughter of James Holland, at Arthur Bryan's, dead, as being ye earnest request of its dying Mother, Mary Holland. God-father Thomas Carey Burke.
- 18 *Sun.* Christened James Callahan, a child of James Callahan, at St. Joseph's. Sponsors. Bradly & Elizabeth Corkrell.
- MARCH** 25 *Sun.* Buried, James Ewen, Jr., at the widow Ewen's, Caroline Cty. Funeral sermon.
- APRIL** 9 *Mon.* Baptized William Ford's negro child at St. Joseph's. God-mother: Rebecca Corkrell.  
Buried, James Fish, at St. Joseph's.  
Buried Burke child of Capt. Edward Burke.
- 12 *Thurs.* Married James Seth and Juliana Cheeves, by license. At St. Joseph's of Queen Anne. Sic people present - names unknown.
