- APRIL** 7 *Sun* Married Gideon and Isabella by note, belonging to Mr. Wm. Tilghman, at Queen's Town. The congregation present.
- 7 *Mon* 8 Buried, James and Charles Imbert, brothers, at Murphy's place, Piny Neck, Queen Anne. Funeral sermon.
- 14 *wed* 10 Buried ~~London~~ _____, at John Blake's on Wye, an old negro called London.
- 21 *Sun* 21 Married, negroes Bob and Hannah of Jac. Seth, by note at Queen's Town, many of ye congregation present; and Mrs. Coursey's Austin, to Charles Brown's Grace.
- 28 *Sun* 28 Married, Mr. Edw'd Coursey's Bob, to Mr. Tuite's wench Peg, by note, at St. Joseph's. Bob's brother, our Tilly, and others present.
- MAY** 12 *Sun* Buried, Sarah Rhodes, at St. Joseph's. Wife of Jeffy.
- 5 *Sun* 12 Married Mr. John Robert's woman Sarah, to our Sam, at St. Joseph's, by note. Test: Jenny and others.
