Buried, two white children of Ch. and James Seth.  
Buried, Betsy Dersens(Downs?), at Jac. Seth's. Funeral sermon.

14 Married, William Ringgold to Poolsy Blake, by license at Wye. The family present.

29 Buried, Mary Bramble, wife of Tommy, Indian Town, Dorset. Funeral sermon.

JULY
