MARYLAND LEGISLATURE

THE RESTRUCTURING BILL.
The congressional redistricting bill passed the Maryland House of Delegates on the 23d by the close vote of 46 to 43 and has been referred to the committee on federal relations in the Senate. The passage of the bill in the House was attended by a great deal of excitement, and in the Senate also it is expected the vote will be close. The bill transfers Carroll county to the sixth district, and Montgomery to the fifth. The first ward of Baltimore city is transferred to the second district and the fifteenth ward to the third district. Western Maryland, Carroll county, is transferred to the fourth district. The bill is expected to pass the House in a few days.

THE HOUSE AND MEANS COMMITTEE.

THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
The Senate on Tuesday afternoon passed a bill for the appropriation of public schools \$125,000, instead of \$100,000, also appropriating \$125,000 to the colored schools, in stead of \$100,000.

THE MILITIA APPROPRIATION.
The Senate also passed a bill for the appropriation of \$16 to 7 to reduce the appropriation for the militia from \$50,000 to \$30,000.

THE NEW ELECTION LAWS.
Governor Jackson has made careful inquiry into the provisions of the new election laws as they relate to the counties. As the laws are enacted with amendments, the legal gentlemen who looked into the matter have concluded that it is not necessary that the registers appointed some time since for the counties should be reappointed. This conclusion was reached after a careful study of the laws and the registers have been reappointed.

THE GENERAL ASSESSMENT BILL.
The general assessment bill was abandoned for want of time to give it the consideration which its importance demanded. The bill repealing the bounty on hawk and owl heads in Kent county was approved by the Governor February 17th.

THE HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTIONS.
The House joint resolutions introduced by President Cleveland's tariff measure were adopted by the Senate on Thursday.

THE INVESTIGATING COMMITTEE.
