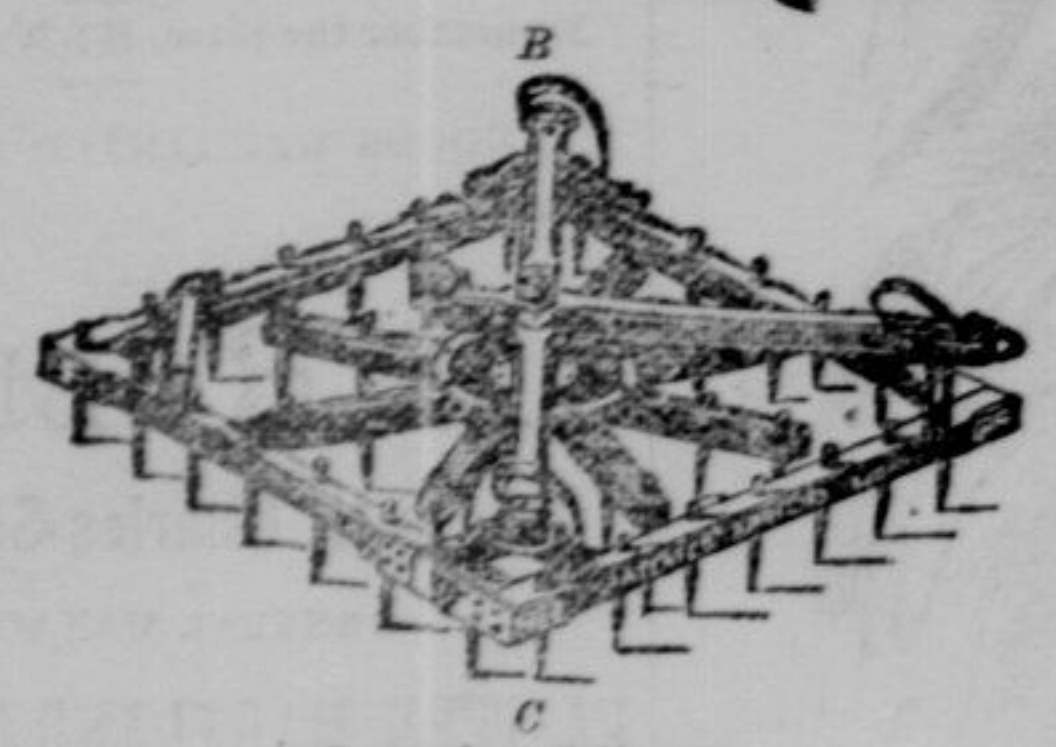
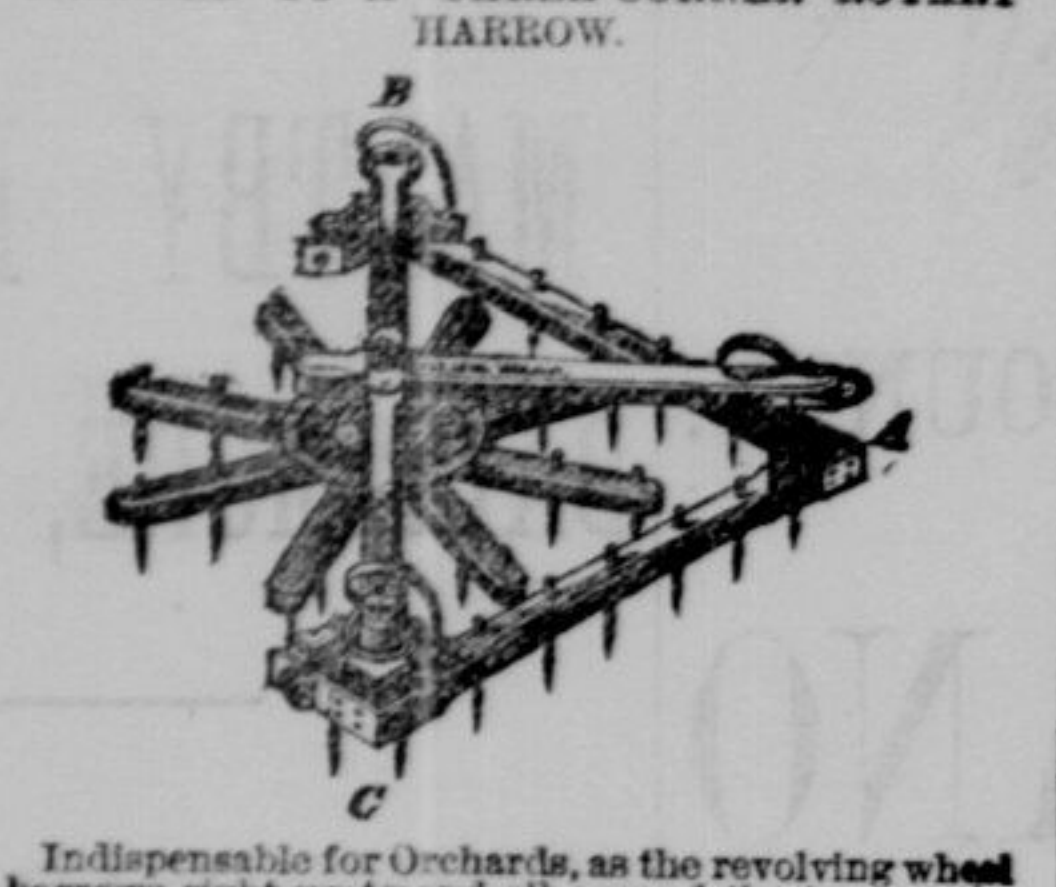

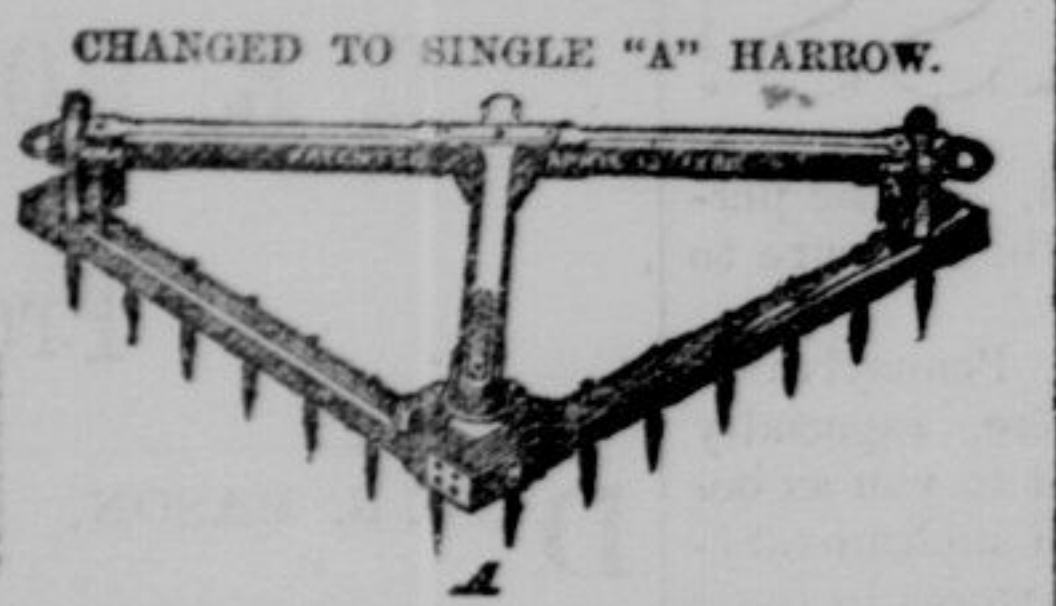


The above cut represents the Penn Harrow... It has no equal in the world.

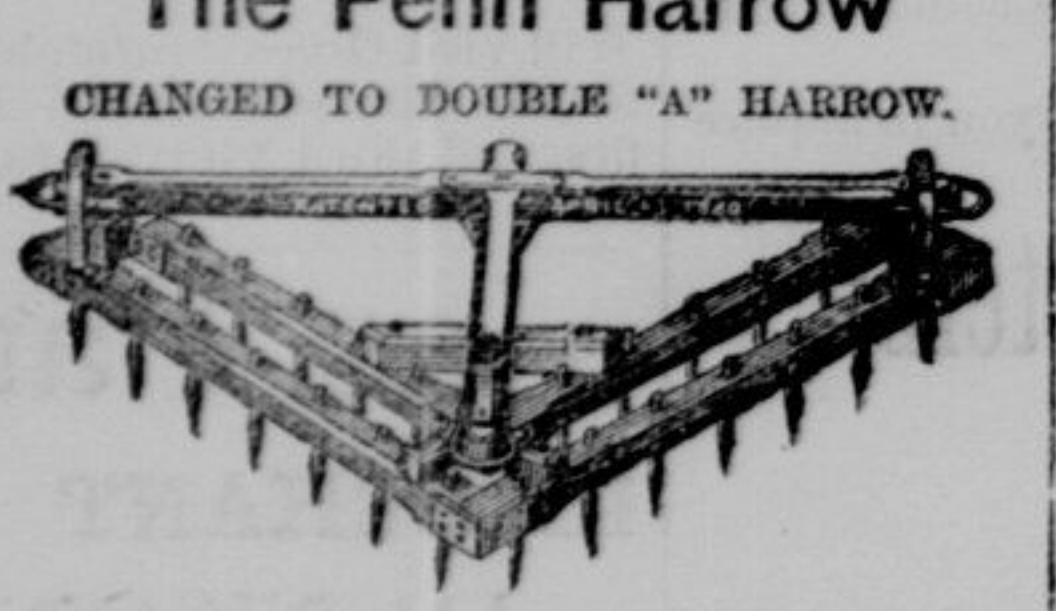
The Penn Harrow CHANGED TO A THREE-CORNER BOTARY HARROW.



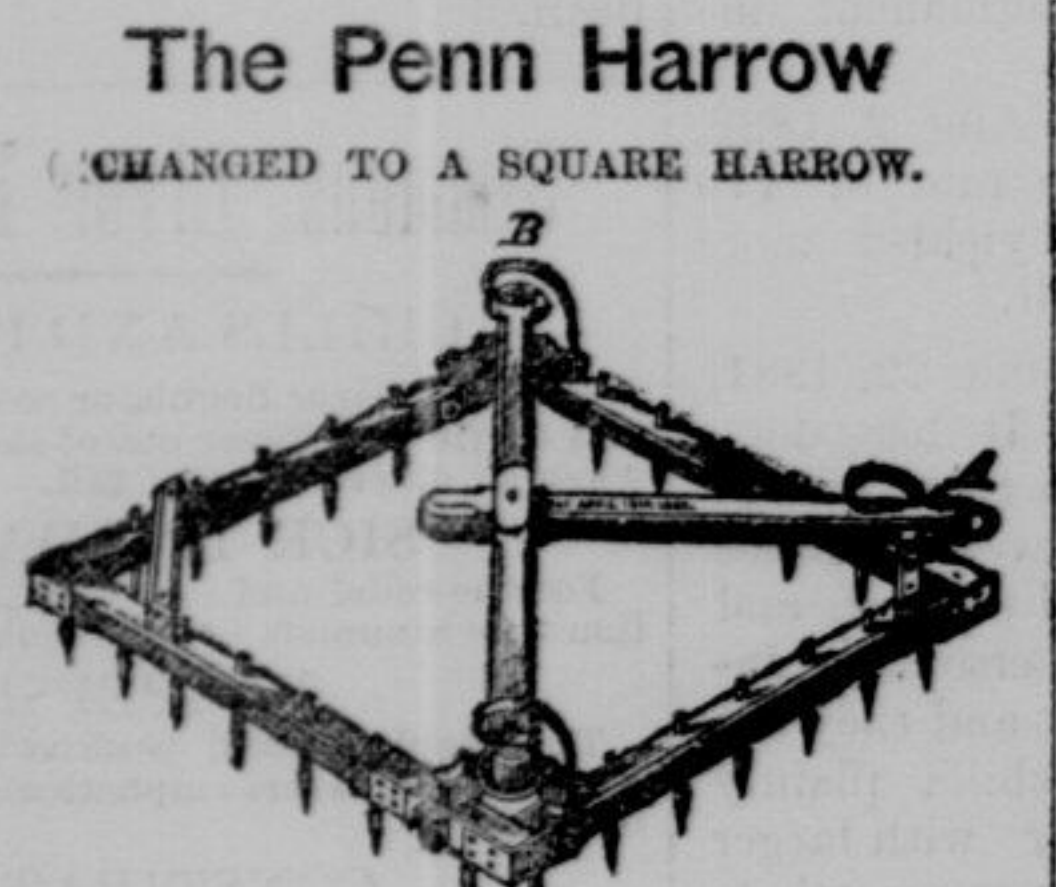
