In July and August, more than a hundred children in contact with tuberculosis will receive treatment at the house at Claiborne. Said Mr. Matthews, of the house.

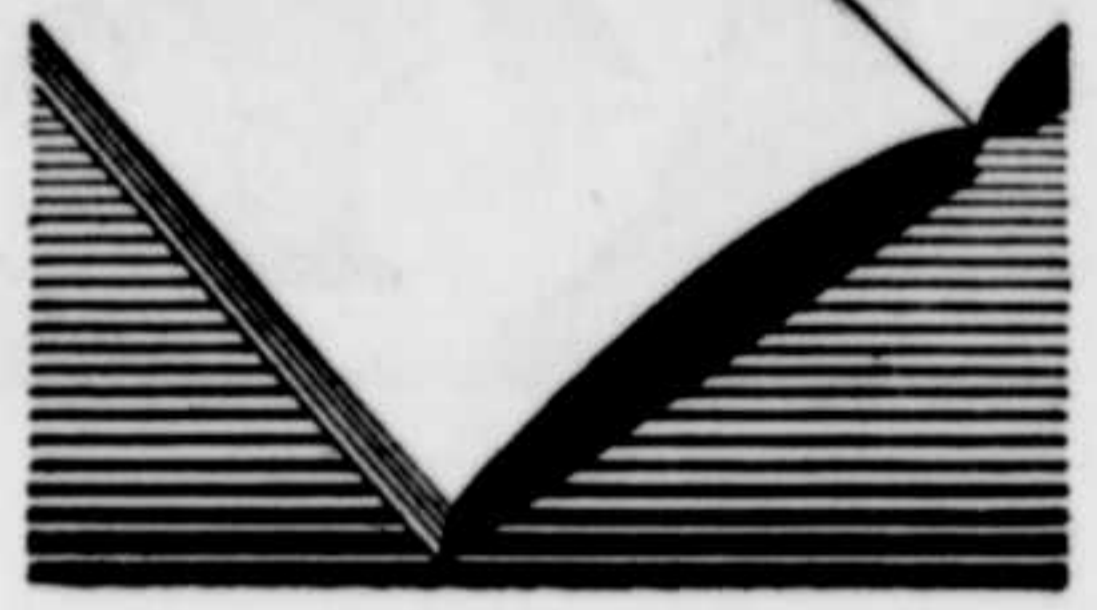
"During our twenty-three years, we have restored hundreds of children to health, making them more useful citizens for our country."

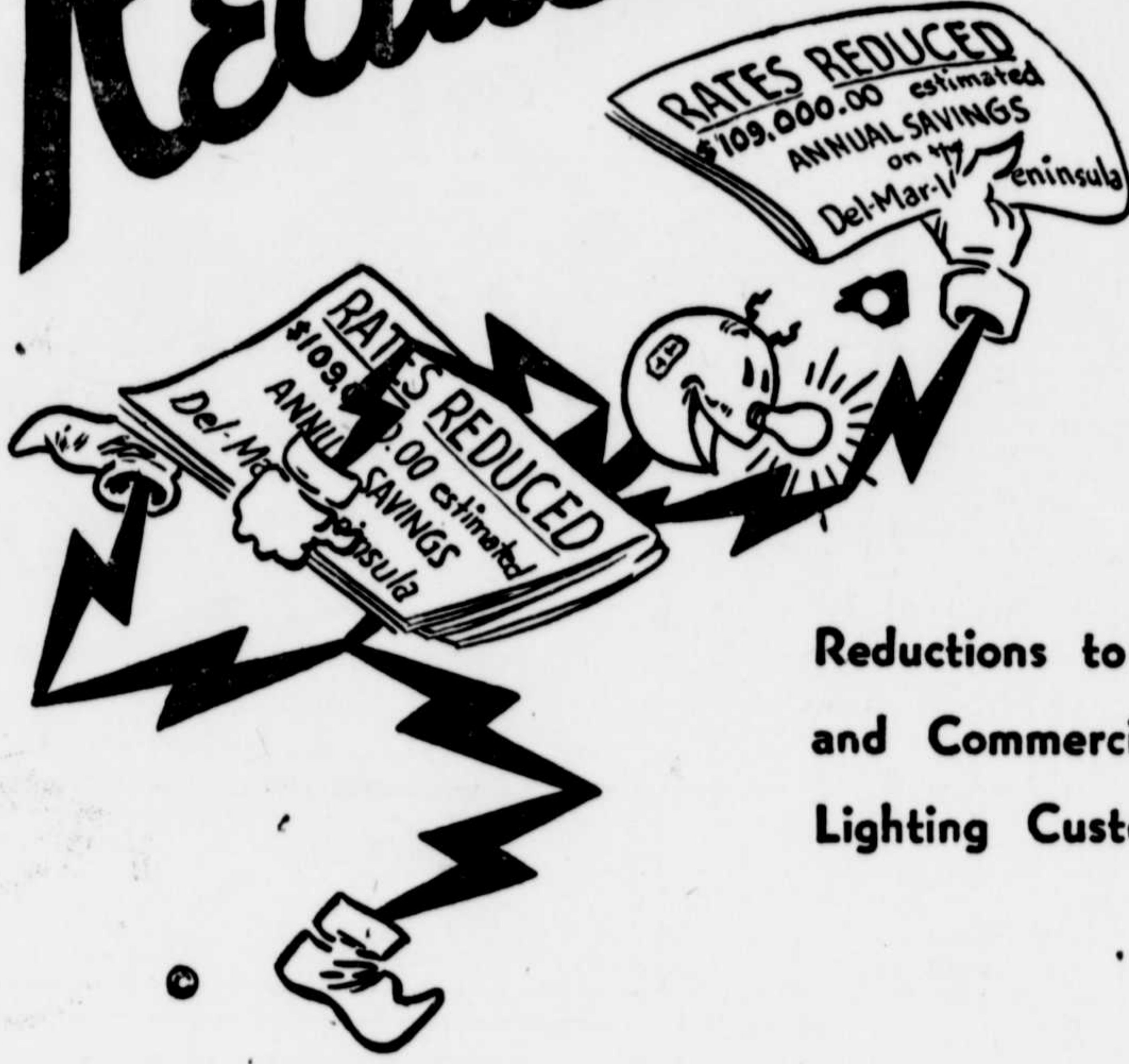

Reduced AGAIN!



Reductions to Residential
and Commercial General
Lighting Customers.

New low rates affecting Residential Customers and Commercial Lighting (and small power) Customers will become effective after the June reading. These rate adjustments will affect customers served by the Company's Interconnected System in Maryland and Delaware.

Furthering a Company policy to reduce rates whenever possible, this is the sixth rate reduction made by the Company in recent years and \$109,000 savings of this reduction brings the total savings during this period to \$610,000.

Reductions have been made possible through increased use of electricity by our customers and through the application of every possible economy to the operation of our business. These factors have enabled us to continue our rate reduction policy despite higher taxation and higher material and labor costs.

We trust that our customers will take full advantage of this rate reduction and, through further availing themselves of the services which we offer, will help us to make future reductions a possibility.

CHECK THESE SCHEDULES WITH PRESENT BILLS TO DENOTE SAVINGS

New Residential or Domestic Rate	
\$1.20	for first 13 kilowatt hours or less per month
6c	per kilowatt for next 27 kwh per month
5c	per kilowatt for next 35 kwh per month
3c	per kilowatt for next 75 kwh per month
2c	per kilowatt for next 3850 kwh per month
1½c	per kilowatt for all over 4000 kwh per month

*Commercial General Light and Power Rate	
\$1.20	for first 13 kilowatt hours or less per month
6c	per kilowatt for next 172 kwh per month
5c	per kilowatt for next 315 kwh per month
4c	per kilowatt for next 750 kwh per month
3c	per kilowatt for next 1000 kwh per month
2½c	per kilowatt for all over 2250 kwh per month
(*For Commercial Customers with less than 20 kw demand.)
