

Clinics Help Fight Tuberculosis

Diagnostic Clinics Of Tuberculosis Association Make Possible Early Discovery Of Disease.

The purchase of Christmas Seals by the citizens of Maryland has made possible in this state a system of clinics for diagnosing diseases of the chest. These clinics are operated by the Maryland Tuberculosis Association in cooperation with the State Department of Health.

The clinics are held monthly in each county of the state and are conducted by tuberculosis specialists, many of whom are the superintendents of the various state sanatoria. The clinics are free to all patients.

Last year there were 236 clinics throughout the state. Examined at the clinics were 4,737 patients, 3,415 of whom were white and 1,322 who were colored. Most of the patients were either former tuberculosis cases who had returned for observation or were people who had some reason to suspect that they might have the disease. Many others had been living in contact with the disease and wanted to take all precautions against getting or spreading it.

Of those examined 522 were found to

have active tuberculosis, 1,317 were arrested or cured cases, 512 were suspects (to be kept under observation), and 2,386 were negative.

Fifty-four of the active cases were children under fourteen years of age. Diagnostic clinics are very important in the campaign to discover tuberculosis early. When discovered early it is easier to cure and the cost of treatment is less. To cure advanced disease is less certain and more difficult and is also more expensive—requiring a long period of time. Moreover, the earlier that the disease is found the less chance there is for the afflicted person to spread the disease to others.

Everyone in Maryland has a chance to help with this work. The Christmas Seals are now on sale and by buying them the people of the state make these clinics possible and at the same time contribute to the security of their communities.

Other activities of the Maryland Tuberculosis Association that are made possible by the sale of Christmas Seals are: the Miracle House at Clabarna, medical research, a clinic for instructing colored physicians in tuberculosis diagnosis, X-raying and tuberculin testing, and the purchase of important diagnostic equipment.

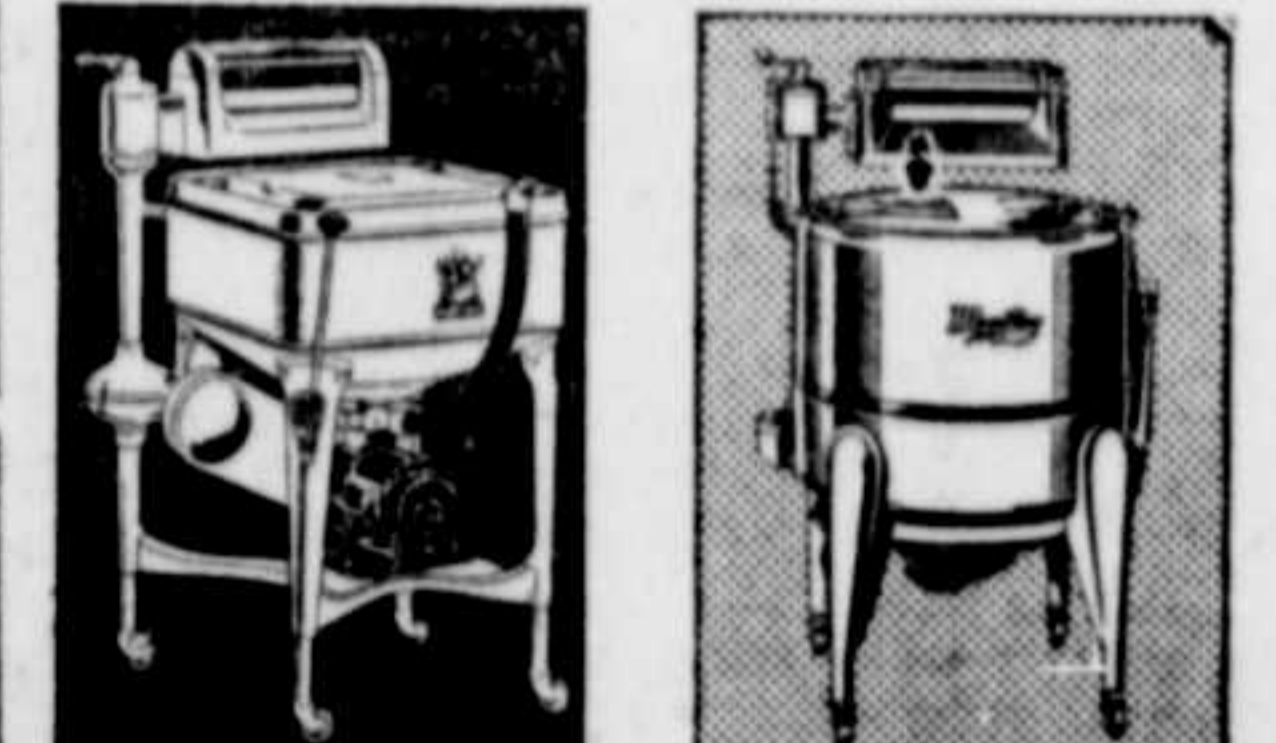
