For the floor she had a black marbled linoleum put in and on the blank wall alongside of the door she hung a framed chart outlining her basic canning recipes—some old standbys handed down from her mother, others copied from here and there and still others originated by her own experiments.

When chocolate is used care must be taken that it is prepared in such a way that it will blend smoothly with the other ingredients of the recipe. For cake and cookies it may be melted over hot—not boiling—water.

Lattice-Topped Pies.—Fruit and berry pies with lattice-style tops require less baking time than the regular full-crust toppers.

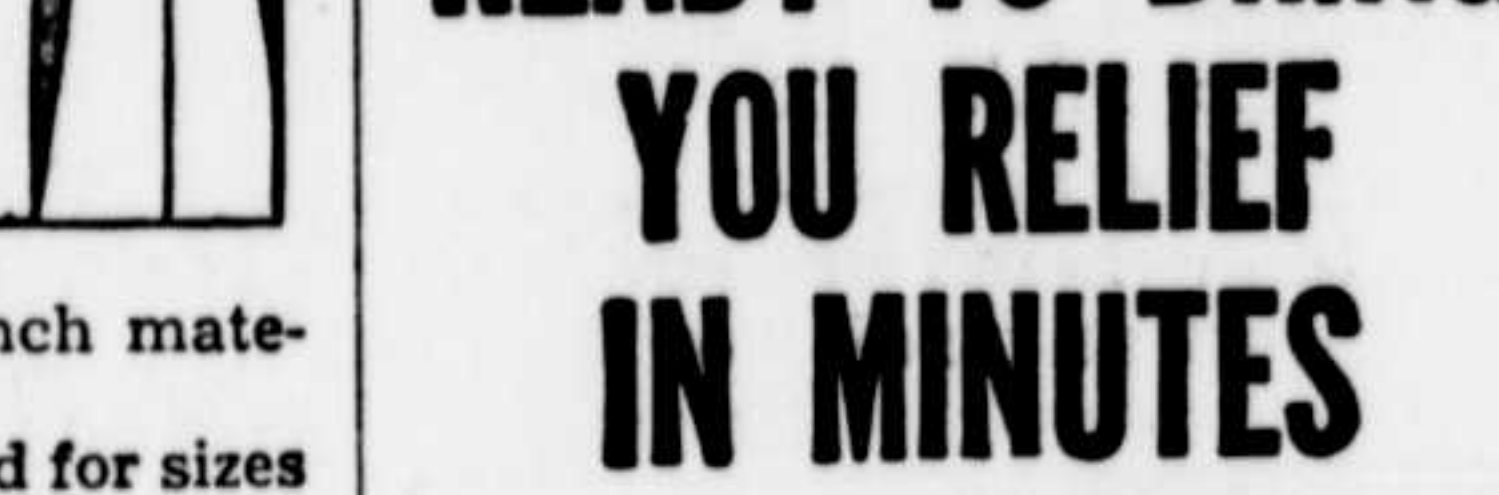
To Wash Curtains.—Lace curtains before being washed for the first time should be soaked for an hour or two in cold water to which two tablespoons of table salt have been added.
