



A SPOILED RECORD VOYAGE.—The largest ship in the American merchant marine, the S. S. Leviathan, stuck fast in the mud at Robbins Reef, upper New York Bay. The giant vessel had just completed what was to be her record-breaking round trip when, owing to dense fog and slight miscalculations, ran on to the mud banks skirting the narrow channel. The united efforts of a score of tugs were necessary to refloat her after having been stranded for six hours. The ship suffered no serious damages.
