

Residents in this province) for any  
sum above five shillings in  
any one voyage, without leave  
from the Commande of the Ship  
shall lose their debt. And any  
Note, Bill, Bond taken by a Pub-  
lick House keeper for such Debt  
shall be void.

Victualles of entertaining or  
harbouring Sailors without leave  
licence of their Master to the  
Commande of the Ship or Com-  
mande, shall be liable to  
the Penalties of such Act  
with servants.

This Act does not extend to the  
Master or chief mate of any  
Vessel. — Bacon
