

the principal debtor on Return  
of the Warrant and Payment  
of Costs thereon —

The Constable shall give notice  
to the Plaintiff or his Agent, if  
either of them reside in the hun-  
dred, of the time and place  
where he intends to carry the  
Defendant before a Justice; if  
neither the Plaintiff having  
notice as aforesaid nor his Agents  
nor the Plaintiff or any one for  
him when such Plaintiff lies  
out of the hundred, with a  
written notice shall appear  
on the Return of the War-  
rant, or at the future day  
or place where appointed

by the Justice, such Justice  
may hear & determine the  
controversy & costs —

Either party may appeal from  
the Determination of a Magis-  
trate if the sum exceeds 33/4  
or two <sup>shillings</sup> to the next County  
court, but no Execution shall  
upon Judgment of such Magis-  
trate shall be stayed, <sup>or appeal</sup> unless  
the Appellant shall immedi-  
ately enter into Bond, with  
sureties to be approved of by  
the S<sup>d</sup>. Magistrate, in double  
the sum recovered, with condi-  
tion, to prosecute the same  
with effect according to the  
Directions of this Act and  
also to pay the party d. in  
case
