BY THIS DAY'S MAIL.

QUEBEC, September 3.

In consequence of the preparations for war which have been resorted to in the U. States, during the existing differences between that country and Great Britain, similar measures have been recently adopted in this part of his majesty's dominions.

During the last ten days a levy of one-fifth of the militia men, between the age of 18 and 50 has been effected, nearly throughout the whole province.

The zeal which has been manifested on this occasion, with the exception of here and there a few individuals, will do lasting honor to the province of Lower Canada.

MONTREAL, September 7.

This city, in the course of the week past, has been honored with the company of his excellency lieutenant-governor Gore, of the Upper Province, the honorable chief justice Alcock, the attorney-general, and a number of other gentlemen of distinction.
