

DECLARATION FOR AN ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Md., City of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 1st day of July A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety personally appeared before me a Deputy Clerk of the Superior Ct. a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid Thomas J. Harris aged 43 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical J. Harris who was ENROLLED as a Priv on the 31 day of Mar, 1864 in Company G of the 39 regiment of U.S.C. commanded by Ogden B. Read and was honorably DISCHARGED at Smithville on the 22 day of Nov, 1865; That his personal description is as follows: Age 20 years; height 5 feet 9 inches; complexion mulatto hair black; eyes black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at near Fort Fisher in the State of N.C. on or about the day of Jan'y 1865, he had his feet were frost bitten & shortly before this on of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.)

Weldon R.R. contracted deafness of left & part of right ear from percussive of guns. Draws now \$4 per month by Cor 94,464 but claims increase therefor also claims under AC. - June 27 1890.

That he served for more than 90 days during the late war That he is suffering from rupture, rheumatism, deafness & frost bitten a permanent physical disability & is unable to earn a support.

That since disability is not due any vicious habits & applies for pension under AC. - June 27 1890. That he was treated in hospitals as follows: (Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.)

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above (Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 22 day of Nov 1865 That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Balto. in the State of Md., and that his occupation has been that of a laborer

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a laborer That he is now wholly disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,

A. Parlee Lloyd of Balto. Md. & agrees to bear & pay him the for of ten dollars his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim That he has received applied for a pension; that his residence is No. 315 S. Durham street Baltimore, Md. and that his post office address is
