Colored Troops was enlisted by Colonel J A Bowman of
 the _____ Regiment of _____ at Baltimore Maryland
 on the 31st day of March 1864, to serve Three years; he was born
 in Baltimore City in the State of Maryland is Twenty
 years of age, 5 feet 9 inches high, Nubatto complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Laborer During the last two
 months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days.* He is suffering from injuries
received since entering the service and in the line of his duty while laying abatis
in front of Petersburg Va rendering him in my opinion unable to perform the
duties of a soldier

 because of varicocele of left spermatic cord, said to have

duty in front of Petersburg Va, July 30th 1864, which
in my opinion is probable,
