I have the honor to return herewith your request for a report of hospital treatment in Claim, No. 300,882, with such information as is furnished by the records filed in this Office, viz: that Sergt. Alfred Mapp, Co. B, 9th U.S.C. I's, was admitted to G. H. Ft. Monroe, Va., Oct. 1, '64, from field, with Contusion right-ankle, wounded by a shell at Deep Run, (Ft. Belmore) Sept. 29, '64, and returned to duty Nov. 2, '64. No further record of this man's treatment found. Lists casualties covering the Regt. Sept. 29, - 30, '64, and records of the Regt., are not in file.
