in the service of the United States, who is an APPLICANT for an invalid pension by reason of alleged disability resulting from Shell wound Rt. ankle & shoulder

Degree of disability.

In our opinion the said Alfred Mapp is 6 per cent 3/4 incapacitated for obtaining his subsistence by manual labor from the cause above stated.

Origin.

Judging from his present condition, and from the evidence before us, it is in belief that the said disability did originate in the service aforesaid in the line of duty.

Probable duration.

The disability is permanent

Particular description.

A more particular description of the applicant's condition is subjoined: Height, 5-10; weight, 170; complexion, dark; age, 32; pulse, 79; respiration, 17

Shell wound of right shoulder - a cicatrix 2 inches in circumference is on upper part of shoulder one inch from acromion, the injury to the shoulder has caused wasting of the muscles of the shoulder, & on the shoulder struck his gun, on account of loss of nerve supply he is unable to elevate arm to head, there has been a partial dislocation ^{upwards} ~~backward~~ & forward, arm one inch shorter than its fellow -
