Volunteers, was enrolled on the 31st day of March, 1864, at Baltimore, Md. and is reported: on rolls from enrollment to June 30/64 present. July & Aug 1864 absent, "Leul Hospital from wounds since July 30th," and so reported to Oct 31/64. Nov & Dec 64 absent, "In Summit Hospital, Phila. since July 30/64, and so reported to Feb 28/65. March & April 65 present, and so reported to June 30/65.

Certificate of disability shows him discharged as Srgt Aug 10/65 at Carolina City, N. C.

As was in action July 30/64 at Petersburg, Va.

Report of Killed, Wounded & Missing of the 39th U. S. C. S. shows J. P. Harris, Srgt, Co "G": wounded July 30/64 at Cemetery Hill, Va. (Character of wound not stated)

The records of this office furnish no further evidence of disability.
