Mariam:

In your claim for reimbursement in the above cited case, you are advised that a certified copy is required of the public record showing the correct date of pensioner's death, for the reason that in your letter of February 4, 1921, you stated that the pensioner died February 3, 1921, at eleven o'clock, whereas in your application for reimbursement you allege that she died February 4, 1921.

A statement is also required, over the signature of John H. Toarvin, showing by whom the payment of \$60 was made on his bill, and that he holds you responsible for the balance due thereon.

A bill is also required from Dr. Ellis, which should contain pensioner's name, and show, over the signature of the doctor, by whom paid, or if unpaid, that you are held responsible for payment.

The enclosed certificate should be signed by Blanche Reeder, and returned.
