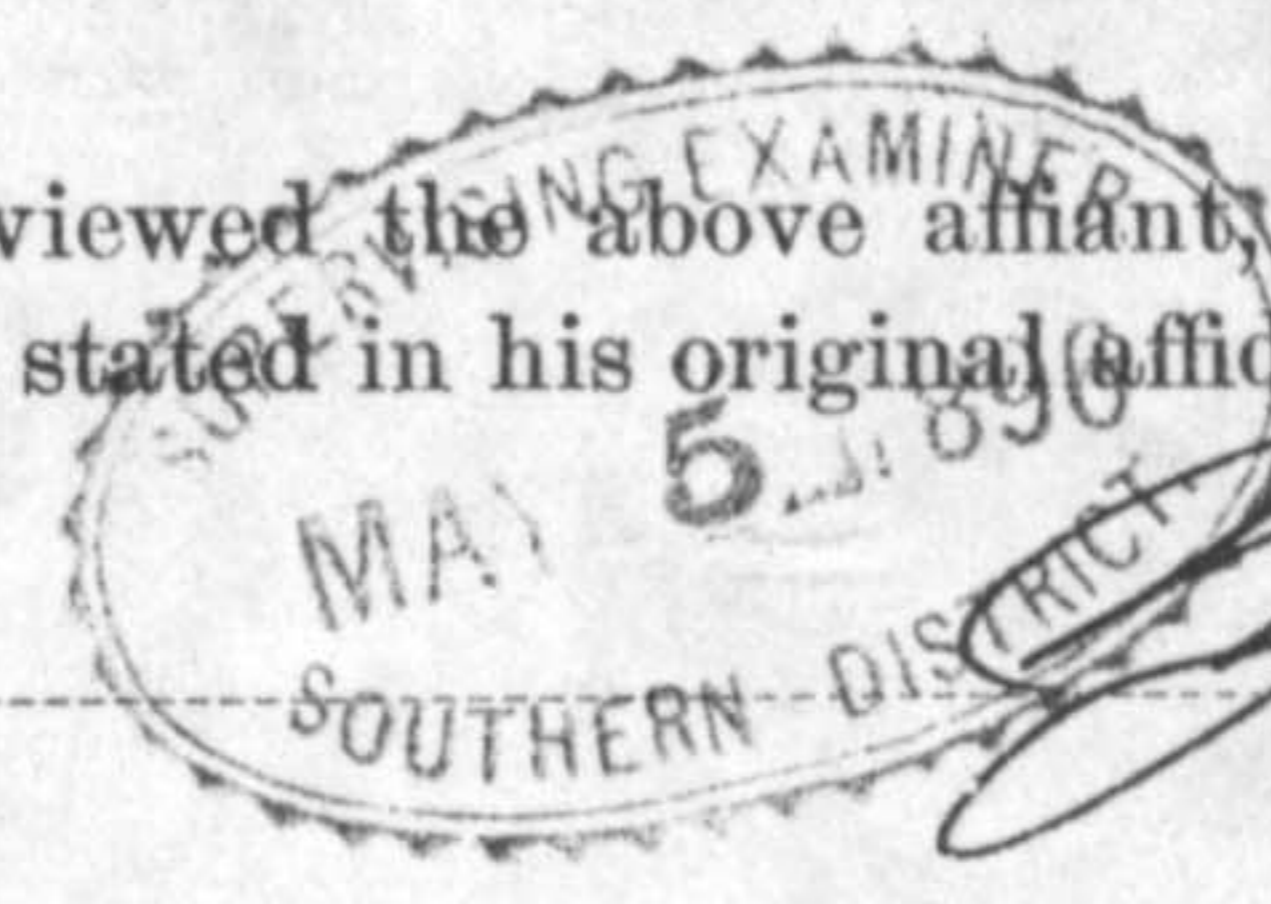
The affidavit was executed before *J. M. Tubman*
