Claims to suffer with rheumatism in shoulders, arms, hips and back. Claims that vision and hearing are impaired. Suffers with diarrhoea every summer with protruding and bleeding piles as result. Claims that he had his left knee dislocated while in the service and that knee is stiff and painful. Unable to perform manual labor by reason of general debility the result of old age. Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 68; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 10 inches; weight, 145 pounds; age, 66 years. General physical condition below par.

General debility the result of old age. Marked Arcus Senilis Rheumatism: Crepitation in the right shoulder with pain on motion in the shoulder and right knee. No deformity of joints. Much sensitiveness of the lumbar muscles. Motion of body is very painful and stopping is impossible. Heart and Lungs are normal. Liver is somewhat enlarged and sensitive; spleen normal. Rectum somewhat congested with enlarged hemorrhoidal veins, but there are no hemorrhoids. Eyes are normal in appearance. Vision is good for age. Ears normal in appearance. Hearing, right ear -40; left 10-40. Claimant would be unable to perform manual labor by reason of senile debility. No other disability exists.
