

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

To be executed before a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, WHO HAS A SEAL.

STATE OF Maryland, COUNTY OF Baltimore, SS.

On this 27th day of July, A.D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

one, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace of the City of Baltimore within and for the County and State aforesaid,

Mrs. Sarah Graham, aged 45 years, a resident of the City Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Md

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of George W. Graham, who enlisted under the name of George W. Graham

at Baltimore City, on the 31st day of March

A. D. 1864, in Co. H, 39th U.S.I. (Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in Military service, or vessel, if in Navy.)

It was never in any other naval or military service.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore City, and died May 20th 1891

That she was married under the name of Sarah Johnson, to said George W. Graham, on the 12th day of January

1860, by Rev. M. D. W. Moore, at Baltimore City

there being no legal barrier to said marriage (If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here

That she has not remarried since the death of the said George W. Graham [Name of soldier or sailor.]

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor. That names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:
