Madam:

In your claim for reimbursement in the case of Isaiah Anderson, Invalid Certificate No. 680257, it is noted you state in your application that the pensioner was never married. You are informed, however, that in 1911 the pensioner stated to a special examiner of this Bureau that he was a widower. You should therefore furnish the affidavit of two witnesses having knowledge of the pensioner's marital history, showing how many times he was married, the full name of each wife, and the date of death or divorce of each.

In case of divorce it will be necessary for you to furnish a certified copy of the decree of the court granting same.
