Sir:-

Relative to your above cited claim for pension under the general law, filed October 23, 1914, you are advised that there is required:

The affidavit of a surgeon, assistant surgeon or hospital steward, showing treatment while you were serving in the United States Navy, for the alleged rheumatism; or the testimony of a commissioned officer or of shipmates, setting forth when, where and under what circumstances the said disability was incurred.

The testimony of each physician who attended you for the said rheumatism from the date of your final discharge to July 19, 1890, and who has attended you for the same from May 23, 1912, to the present time, stating the dates and duration of all treatment and the degree of disability from said cause while under the physician's care; or, if such testimony cannot be furnished, the evidence of credible lay witnesses showing the continuance of the said disability during the periods indicated.
