Declaration for Pension

Under the Act of February 6, 1907

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 15 day of May A. D. one thousand nine hundred and

seven, personally appeared before me

a J. P. within and for the County and State aforesaid

Wm H Bell a resident of the

city of Baltimore County of

State of Md who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is

the identical Wm H Bell who was ENROLLED on the 17

day of March, 1864, in Co K 3d US Artillery

(Here state rank in company and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in Navy.)

in the service of the

United States in the War, and served at least days, and was HONOR-

(Civil or Mexican)

(90 days if Civil War; 60 days if Mexican)

ABLY DISCHARGED at, on the 10 day of Dec, 1865

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated

above

(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he is years of age, having been born on the day of 1829

and asks for a pension of \$.20 per month [62 years of age, \$12; 70 years, \$15; 75 years or over, \$20].

That he has applied for pension under application No. That he

is a pensioner under Certificate No. 5-70476

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States

under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

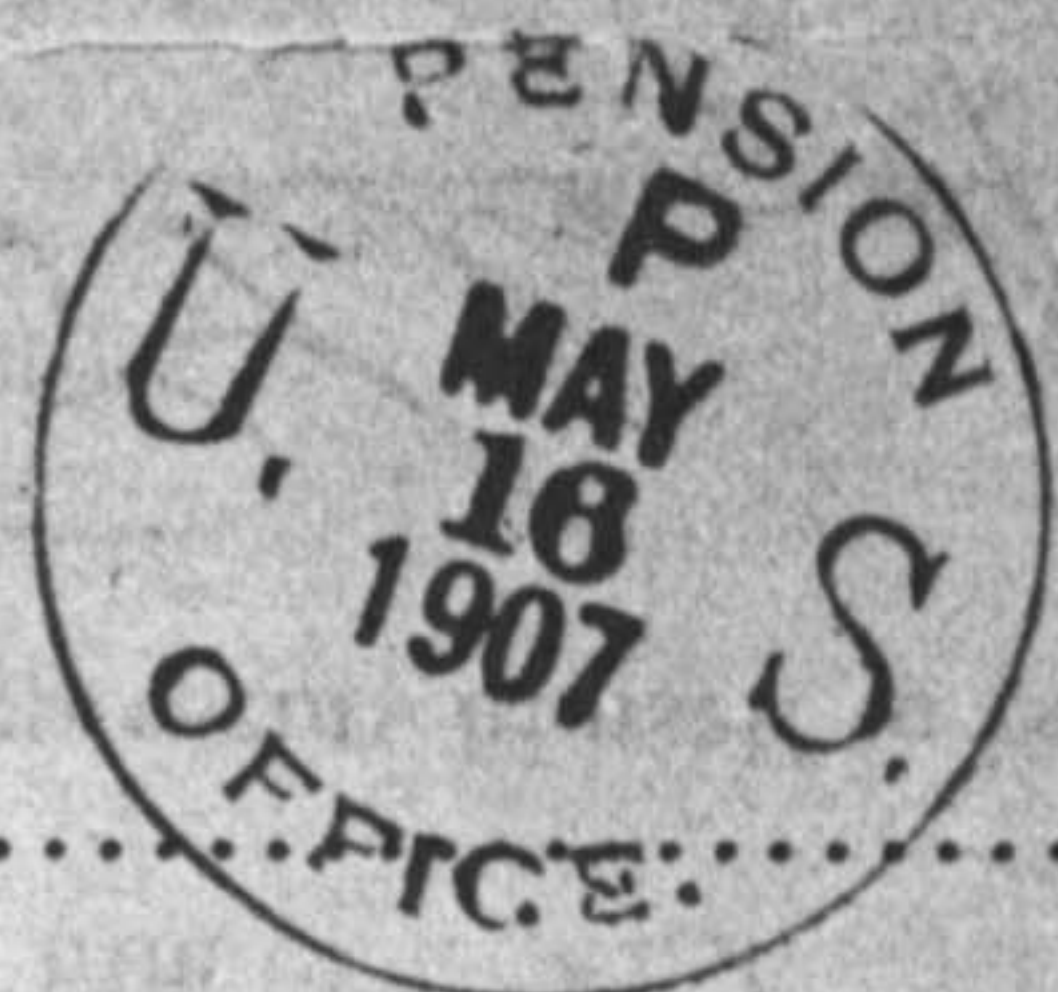
