

Declaration for Restoration to the Pension Roll.

Act of June 27, 1890.

NOTE.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of Clerk of Court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 2nd day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid William W. Bell aged 67 years, a resident of the 1311 Way Street County of Baltimore State of Maryland, who, being

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical William W. Bell who was ENROLLED on the 17th day of March 1864, in 30th Regt. U.S. C. Troops as Private Company and regiment of service, in the Army, or vessel and rank, if the Navy.

in the service of the United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Roanoke Island, N.C. on the 10th day of December, 1865 That he is disabled for earning a support by manual labor in a pensionable degree by reason of the following disabilities:

Asthma

That he is also disabled for earning a support by ☒ Rheumatism, that said

disabilities render him totally disabled

for manual labor, and hereby makes
application for Restoration and Increase of
Pension.

That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character, and that he is now wholly disabled for earning a support by manual labor in consequence of same.

That he was a pensioner on the rolls of the agency at Washington, D.C. under certificate No. 570476 and that he was last paid at said agency on the 10th day of December, 1894 That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of reopening his claim, and being restored to the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints Geo. W. H. Vernon, 313 St. Paul St. Baltimore Md his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and he directs that the sum of ten dollars be paid to said attorney.
