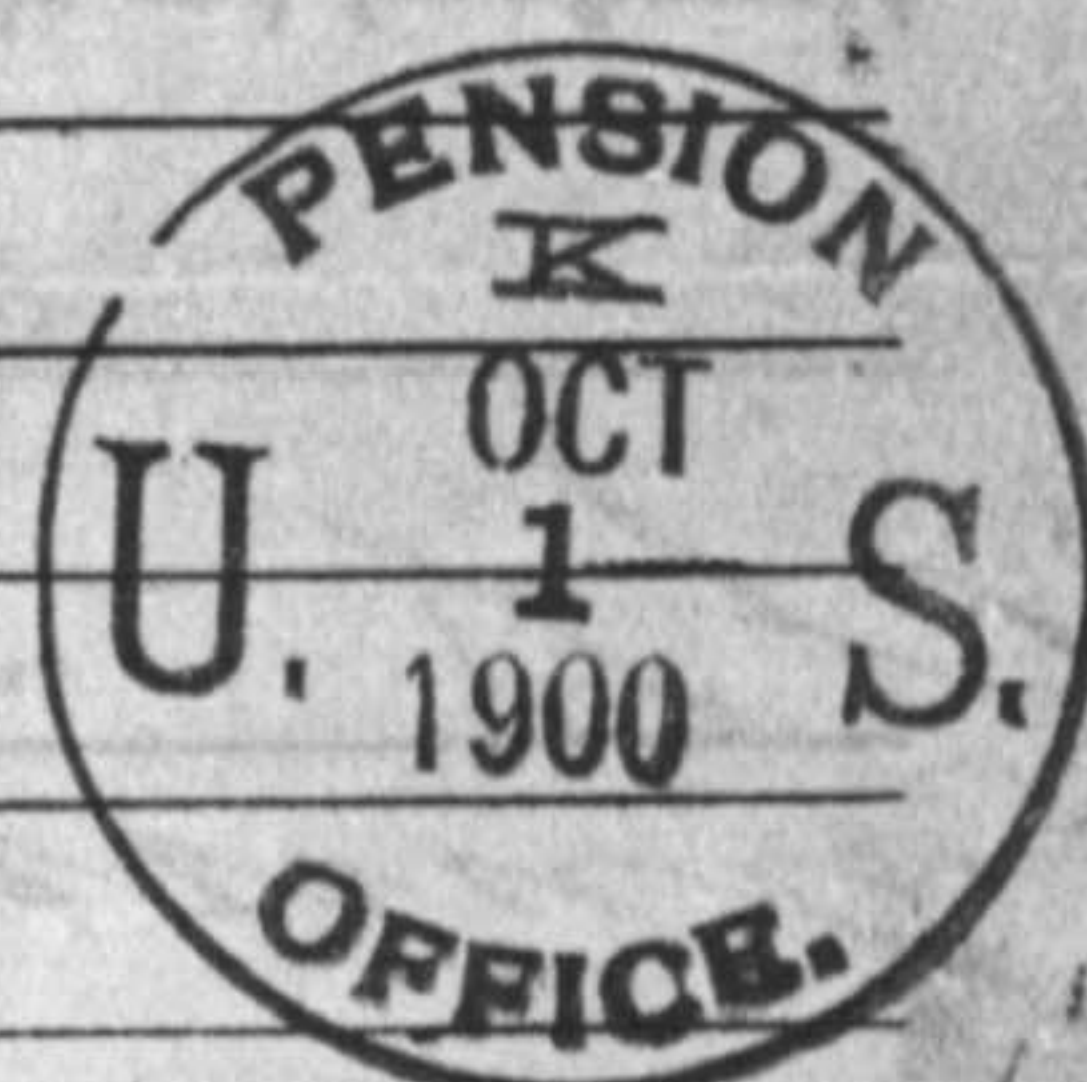
ON THIS 25 day of Sept, A. D. 1900 personally appeared before me
