Sir:

In your above cited claim for pension you should furnish a full statement under oath of all services rendered in the army or navy by you. If in the army, the full name of each organization in which service was rendered should be given, with the letter of the company and the number of the regiment, the names of commanding officers and the dates and places of enlistment and discharge.

If in the navy, the dates and places of enlistment and discharge, and the names of all vessels on which you served should be stated, and you should then state that you had no other service than as alleged.

Your name has not been found upon the rolls of Co. G, 28th U. S. Inf. or Co. G, 28th U. S. C. Inf., or Co. G, 28th Ind. Vol. Inf., as shown by the reports from records of the
