

Now I give the evidence of the doctors  
The first doctor that attended me when  
I came home from the war as I was dis-  
charged a total cripple was doctor  
Dorwin and he attended up until  
August he was not doing me any good.  
he was making me worse and I dis-  
charged him. Then I got doctor King and  
he did me a great deal of good and in 1867  
I was able to do light jobs as I thought I  
getting all right. I lasted till 1875 I was do-  
ing manual labor up till that time  
and then I broke down again and I thought  
I would die. Then I was suffering with  
misery in both of my shoulders, and in  
the small of my back and left hip, also  
my left groin was a hernia growing,  
and my left knee, and I am still suffering  
with the same to day. Dr. S. Shutz was called in  
and attended me for thirteen years or more. Then  
Dr. S. Shutz died. After then I went to  
Hopkins Hospital and they tattooed me all over  
my back with ~~the~~ and shoulders with Red  
Hot Irons. Then they told me there was  
no cure for me. I went there often and on for  
two years. They told me I must not lift
