 ries and Rheumatism came out on me fresh

 etc brought all these injuries out on me fresh  
 again. then I was excused from all duty  
 I was a total cripple from that up un-  
 til I was discharged and I was discharg-  
 ed a couple and scarcely could walk the  
 first doctor attended me was doctor  
 Dorum that was after I was discharged  
 and came home he attended me for quite  
 a while and found he could not do me  
 the any good then I got doctor King he did  
 a great deal of good he patched me up and  
 I last quite a while I broke down again  
 I got doctor Schutze in 1875 and doctor  
 Schutze attended me for over eighteen  
 years up until death and since the  
 death of doctor Schutze I have been treat-  
 ed at Hopkins Hospital and <sup>the doctor</sup> treated me  
 over those injuries with read hot crims  
 ing and they do me no good I am still suffer-  
 ing with these injuries and Rheumatism
