I will bring before you the widow of a man who was with me in the hospital and this woman saw me every other day. Her name is Elizabeth Jackson, also Thomas Jones who has testified but not as frequently as can.

I have understood your questions you have recorded my answers, Recalled,

Q You said when you first went to the hospital the doctor asked you whether you had ever worn glasses, what did you answer, a I replied that I had never worn glasses for the reason that I had never found any to put my eyes. Now he did not suggest any glasses for I told him I never found any glasses I owned or through.
