Yes, I am sure he had rheumatism while in the service - he walked with a cane at Carolina City in South Carolina, and he told me he had rheumatism. No, he did not get over it - he has rheumatism now.

I know that because when he gets down he can hardly get up - can hardly walk sometimes.

Yes, he had some diarrhoea in the service - that was at Carolina City too. I know he had it because I often went to the privy with him - they nearly all had diarrhoea - it came from drinking bad water down there.

Yes, he got over that.

2 When did you first see him after the war?

A The first time I saw him was when I met him on Lexington St. in this city - that was a year or so ago. I cannot tell whether he has had any of the diseases named since the war.

By the Claimant - The witness made a mistake when he locates Carolina City - it is in North Carolina - not South Carolina - our Regiment never was in North Carolina.
