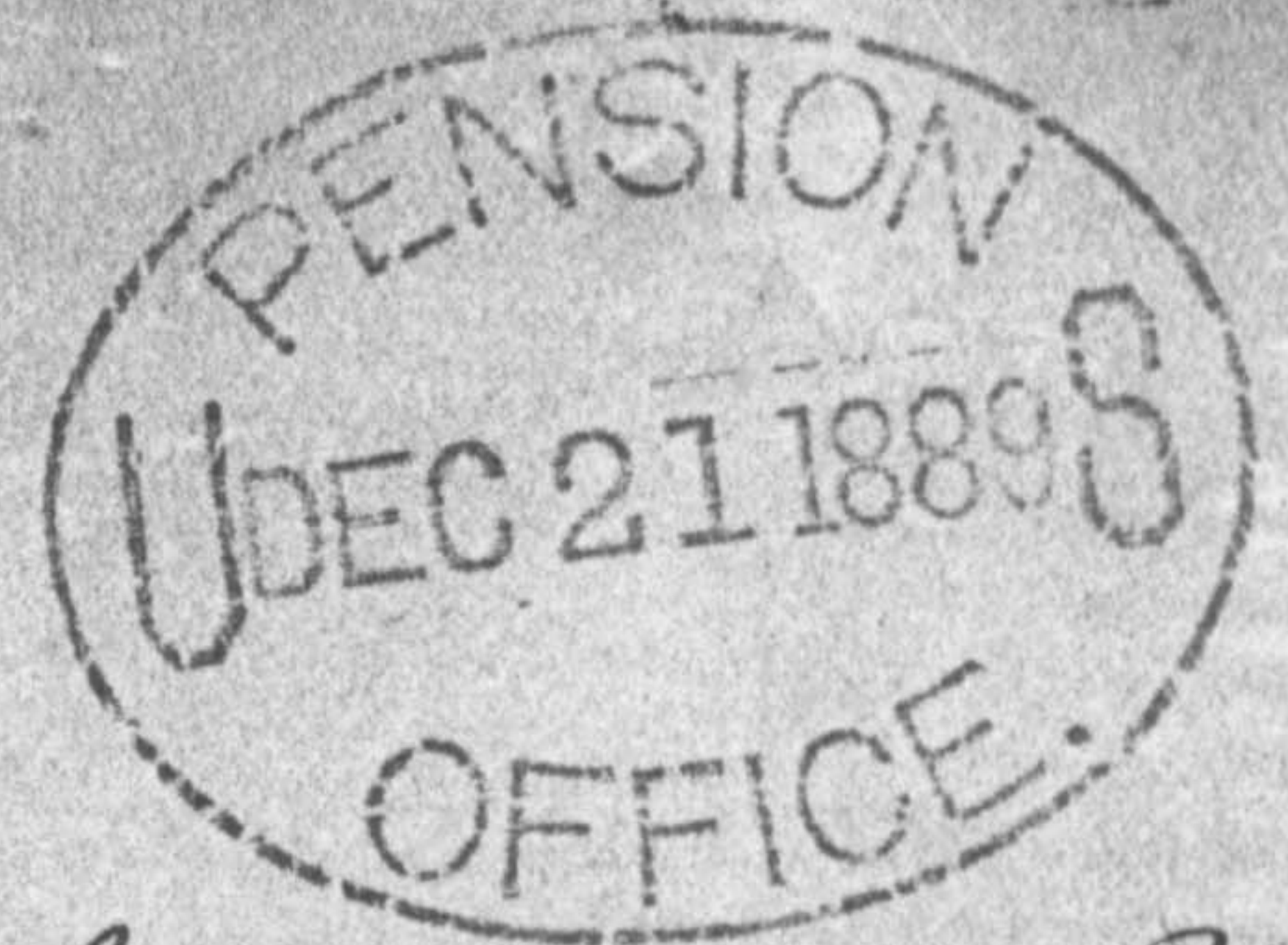

I went to reside in Hull's Lane near Forrest St. Baltimore and have lived in that immediate neighborhood ever since. I carried on business as shoe dealer at Annapolis Md between 1866-1872 but kept my family in Baltimore & ran back & forth. My disabilities are Piles, Diarrhoea, Rheumatism and Disease of Eyes contracted as set forth in my application. I was first treated by Regt Surgeon Tucker but was in Genl Hospital. Since my discharge I have been treated by Dr Ridout at Annapolis & Dr Gibney in Baltimore but both of these physicians are dead. Dr Fenby attended about a year ago. I have not been able to do any manual labor since my discharge.
