Madam:

In reply to your letter of the 13th instant received on the 14th concerning the disallowance of your claim for reimbursement in the case of Margaret A. Dashiells certificate No. 380,293, you are informed that if you wish a reconsideration of your claim you should file your affidavit setting forth your charges for nursing the pensioner during her last sickness, from July 8, 1912, to the date of her death, stating clearly the rate per day or per week, and also stating any additional expense incurred by you during her last sickness, not set forth in your original declaration.
