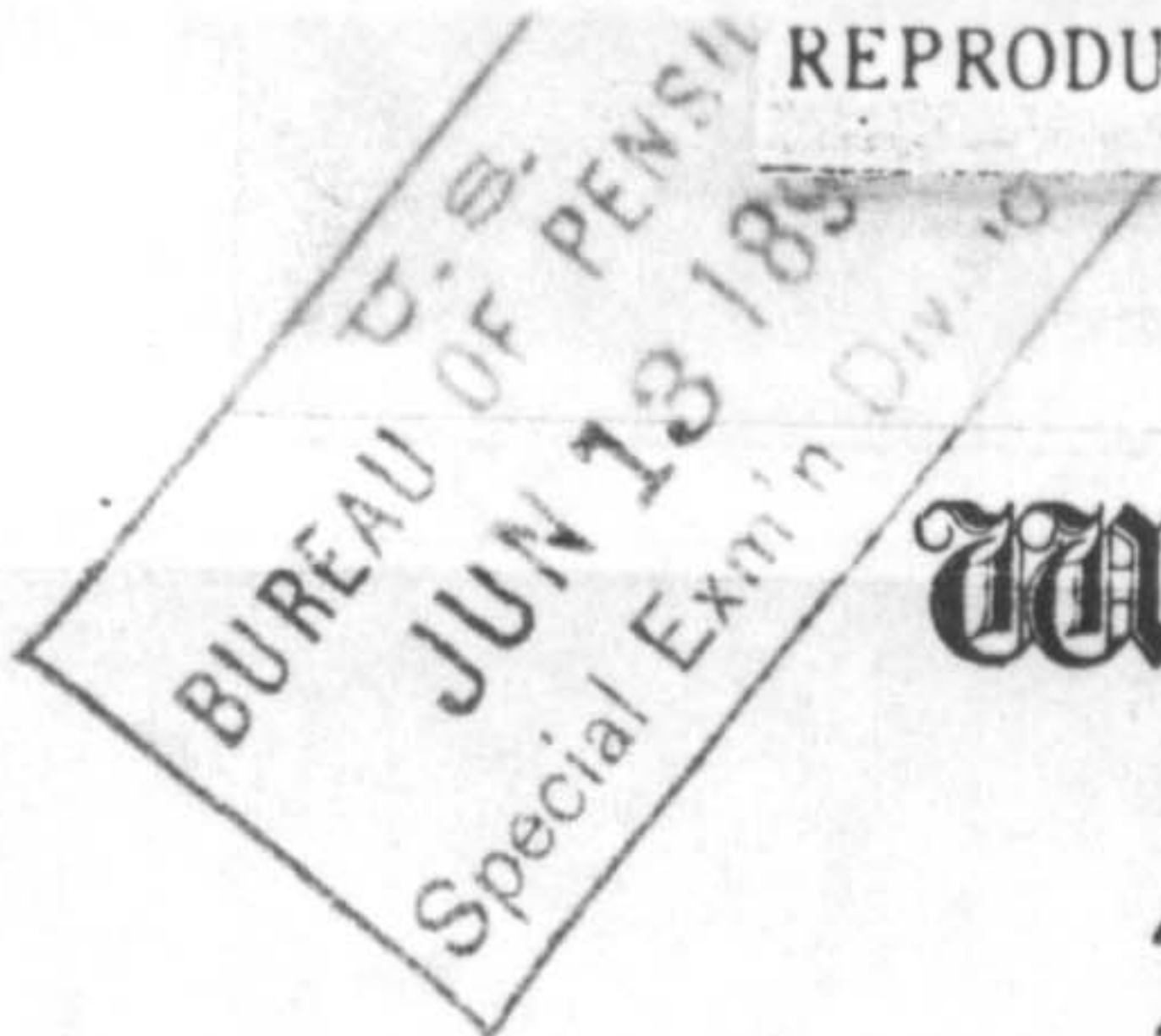

SIR:

Your inquiry of *May 4th*, 1884, in Pension Claim No. *511934*,
is herewith returned, with the following information:

Thomas Beechield was enrolled on the *28th* day of
May, 1864, at *Baltimore City, Md.*, as a *Private*
in Co. *B*, *19th* Regiment of U. S. Colored *Troops*, to serve *3* years.

He is reported on Muster Roll *for May & June 64 present for duty*,
"Recruit from depot June 20. 1864"; July & Aug and
to Dec. 31. 64 present for duty; Jan. & Feby. 1865 present
with remark, "On detached duty at Jones Land-
ing since Dec. 12. 1864;" March & April and May &
June, present for duty; July & Aug. and to Dec. 31. 65
present "Company cook;" Jan. & Feby and to Dec.
31. 66 present for duty.

He was mustered out of service with company
January 15. 1867 at Brownsville, Texas. Borne on
some rolls as Thomas A. Dashiells.

Records on file do not show wound, nor injury alleged.
Co. Morning Reports covering Jan. 1864, to Jan. 1867, show him
Sept. 19/64, from duty to Hospital; Sept. 24/64, from Hospital to duty;
cause for which in hospital not stated; they show Station during
July 1864 "In the Field Va" & July 30th 1864 in action.

Company Returns covering March 1864, to Dec. 1866, save May,
June, July, Aug. & Oct. 1864, Jan. & Oct. 1865, do not report
him sick.

Regimental Hospital Records are not on file.
