in and for the State and City aforesaid, personally appeared Epoch Waters and Richard
Valley both of Co A 19th U S C S resident of 370 Cross St and 62 South Ave County of
Baltimore and State of Md, to me well known, and whom I certify to be

respectable and intelligent, and entitled to full credit and belief, and who being duly sworn according to law, declared that
they were members of Co A 19th U S C S that they
were at the Battle of Petersburg and have personal
and perfect knowledge that their comrade Thomas
H. Dashiells was wounded at front of Petersburg in
July 1864 while in line of battle, in the left leg
midway between ankle & knee cap, also by same
shell just below said knee cap, and that on the
same day he was knocked down and tramped upon
by the enemy, wounding his back; also wounded
by a bayonet in calf of left leg same time & place
that they were present and heard him tell of his
wounds and disabilities up until their discharge.
He was sent to the Jackson Hosp. for treatment.

And they have no interest in the claim of Thomas Dashiells for Pension
