in the service, viz. Shell wound left leg below ankle & knee also wd. near knee cap & bayonet wound in calf of same leg - injury of back ch Rheumatism - disease of heart and disease of eyes. I & S dollars per month.

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims that wound of left leg causes constant pain - difficulty in walking - Bayonet wound in calf of left leg - pain in back result of injuries received by being trampled upon Rheumatic pains about heart Vision is impaired

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 84; respiration, 18; temperature, 99; height, 5 feet 6 inches; weight, 150 pounds; age, 60 years. General physical condition fair. Scar at tubercle of left tibia extending from median line outward - one inch long 1/2 inch wide - adherent - dragging and slightly sensitive. No interference with movements of knee. No evidence of shell wound between knee and ankle - or of bayonet wound in calf of left leg. No scar or other evidence of injury to back. No crepitation - or deformity in joints - or parson motion - or other evidence of Rheumatism. Heart and lungs are normal. Eyes - Cornea and conjunctiva clear. Pupils equal and normal. Vision 20/70 both eyes. Ordinary failure of vision due to age. No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 3/18 rating for the disability caused by Wound left knee & S for that caused by Bayonet wd. in calf of same leg & ankle & S that caused by Ch. Rheumatism - Disease of heart - Disease of eyes
