Personally came before me, a Justice of the Peace, in and for aforesaid.....City.....and State.

Josiah Cornish aforesaid Claimant
citizen of.....Baltimore.....and State of Maryland; who are reputable

and entitled to credit, and who being duly sworn, declare in relation to the foregoing case, as follows:

That in response to requirement dated Jan 15th 1880, says that he is unable to furnish the Medical evidence required for the reason that the Medical Doctors to whom he went for attention and Medicine are now deceased. He is therefore unable to furnish said evidence. Dr Buckler Jones, whose office was NE Corner of Calvertth and Broadway in Baltimore City was the first Dr. this affiant called upon, and was prescribed for, and treated by him first on or about the 6th or 8th day of May 1866 immediately after his discharge from the Army; as this affiant was suffering very much on account of the wounded arm and his breast, and was then spitting blood; he also declares that Dr Joseph W Cockbill, South Broadway, became this affiant's Physician after the death of Dr Buckler Jones, and so continued until he died, which was some time in 1878. Since which time this affiant has used such Medicine, as he would have recommended to him, and would be able to get, had he been able to pay a Doctor - And declares that his condition physically at this time is not much better than when he was discharged. As he is entirely unable to earn a support even at this time - and that this
