 injured at Fort Slocum, near Wash-  
 ington D.C. about the first part  
 of January 1866, by being mashed  
 in breast by wheel of Casson  
 against breach of one of the  
 Cannon which was being re-  
 moved at that time, he was  
 removed to Camp Hospital  
 and discharged May 4<sup>th</sup> 1866
