Scar - two inches long by $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide exactly over the articulation of the 1st + 2nd pieces of the sternum - non-adherent - non-sensitive

Scar $\frac{1}{2}$ inches long by $\frac{1}{4}$ inch in width on outer aspect of left arm. running from about the center of the deltoid - downward and forward - non-adherent - non-sensitive not depressed - result of glancing shot from a mine fall - No limitation of motion at the shoulder - Claimed to have great pain in the arm in damp weather

Heart - apex beat is carried downward and forward about one inch - Increased impulse Evidently some hypertrophy No valvular lesion - Lungs normal
