We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Injury to Chest and Gun Shot Wound of Left Arm.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for INCREASE.

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims to have constant pain through the chest as result of injury. Cannot straighten himself on account of pain it causes Gun shot wound of the left arm. Has pain through the arm as a result and is unable to use it in the performance of manual labor.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 76; respiration, 17; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 5 inches; weight, 126 pounds; age, 48 years. General physical condition is below par. Muscles soft. Has a feeble appearance.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for

There is a scar over the sternum at junction of first and second pieces. It is 2 1/2 inches long and 1/2 inch wide.

There is also another scar, one inch below the first, at left side of sternum: one inch long by 1/4 inch wide.

The scars are very similar in character; slightly elevated and have tendency to keloid degeneration; slightly adherent and sensitive. NO flattening or other deformity of the chest.

Scar of gun shot wound on outer aspect of left arm; running obliquely downward and forward across the deltoid above its insertion. Scar is two inches long by 1/4 wide; non-adherent and slightly sensitive. No interference with motions of shoulder. No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a rating for the disability caused by Injury to Breast 6/18 for that caused by Gun Shot Wound of Left Arm 7/18 and for that caused by
