Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 78; respiration, 20; temperature, 98; height, 5 feet 4 1/2 inches; weight, 140 pounds; age, 47 years. Find elevated, puckered Cicatrix 2 1/2 inches long across Middle of Sternum - Tender. Chest flattened - depression of Sternum below Cicatrix. Tender over lower third of Sternum - Man is stooped - Apex beat of heart below ensiform. Area of dullness increased. Heart sounds weak. Respiratory Murmur very feeble. Find Cicatrix of wound across left deltoid 2 inches long. Produces no disability. Find four inflamed internal hemorrhoids, ulcerated and tender. easily protruded. Find Muscles of shoulders back and hips. All movements made slowly and with care. The Man is no doubt a sufferer with Chronic Rheumatism.

No other disability except as above

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 12 rating for the disability caused by Injury to Chest 18 for that caused by Piles 4, and Rheumatism 18 for that caused by
