Injury to Chest: Gun Shot Wound left arm Breast & Pelvis
 Double Hernia - He receives a pension of 17 dollars per month.

He makes the following statement in regard to the origin of his disabilities and date when first discovered by him:

"I have pains in my chest. I cant do much with my left arm. I have piles and am ruptured"

Birthplace, Cambridge Md; age, 70 years; height, 5.4; weight, 130 pounds; complexion, Black; color of eyes, Brown; color of hair, Gray; occupation, none; permanent marks and scars other than those described below, none

We hereby certify that upon examination we find the following objective conditions:

Pulse rate, 78, 79, 86; respiration, 16, 17, 22; temperature, 98.6

Injury to Chest: A small superficial Cicatrix 2 1/2 inches observed at middle of chest about 2 inches below junction of the Clavicle to Manubrium. Scar not tender. Not adherent not dragging. No rotting.

Gun shot wound left arm: A Cicatrix 1 1/2 inch is on outer side of upper middle 3rd of left arm - Superficial - We do not observe any Cicatrix of exit for gun shot wound of left arm. No impairment of function of left arm: he elevates the left arm completely: its prehensile power normal. No deformity nor disability from either wound. No rotting

Disease of Rectum: There are 2 hemorrhoidal tumors - internal - protruding at present - one inch: the right tumor is 1 1/2 + 1/2 inch: the left tumor is 1 + 1/2 inch. Evidence of recent bleeding observed - There is slight prolapse: the size of the whole protruding mass is 2 1/2 + 1 inch. The rectal mucous membrane is inflamed we believe the prolapse is constant. He experiences pain when walking or standing. No fissure no fistula no stricture

Mark: normal in position Size and Action Lungs are sound. Chest Symmetrical Measures ex pector 33 inches of chest 34. Inspiration 35 inches.

His general physical appearance is bad. We find no evidence of Cicatrix of lanced bubo. The gonitasia are in normal condition, excepting the distention of Scrotum by the left hernia.
