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Chas. has tried to work, but since I have married him he has not been able to do a whole days work at a time. I have had to take care of him. The most trouble he has is his piles and his breast and he is utterly broken down. He never has gotten well of the piles and as long as we have been married he has been suffering with the piles. I didn't know how he contracted his piles. I never knew him long before I married him. I married him in October about 28 or 29 yrs. ago. but I can't tell exactly. Chas. still has the piles and he is a constant sufferer from the piles.
