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 He then complained of piles.
 Once at Ft. Stovall he was
 hurt handling a cannon and he
 has complaint of that since war
 but not as much as of piles.
 I don't now recollect his being wound-
 ed. I remember Chas. Jackson & I
 made an affidavit with him
 but I don't now recall if Clint
 was wounded.

Clint. was sick at Petersburg Va
 but I don't know what was the
 matter with him. He complained
 of Piles at Petersburg Va.

The first time in my life I ever
 heard him complain of piles was at
 Yorktown Va.

We were at Yorktown Va before
 we were at Petersburg Va.

Clint. is a man of good habits
 I am correctly reported.

I have heard you read affidavit
 of Jan 9, 1892 and it bears my
 signature & I made it, and
 Clint. had diarrhoea & piles at
 Yorktown Va before we were
 at Petersburg Va.
