Eldery St. - there is a little Court makes up from this street between Central Ave. & Eden St. in one of the houses in this Court the soldier lived in 1865 and continuously up to the date of his death. His physical condition at the date of his discharge and up to the date of his death was that of a man completely broken down - he complained of a pain in the breast and continued steadily to grow worse until he died. He was near neighbors living in the same block.
