This certifies that I attended John Chambers alias John A. Chambers, colored Soldier the husband of Sophia Chambers during his last illness of which he died on or about the 21st day of January 1867 from a violent attack of congestion of his Lungs and Liver after about four or five days illness owing to his previous broken down and feeble condition (and a few weeks after his discharge from the Army) the result of exposure and incident cause attendant to the life of a soldier.

I was well acquainted with said Chamber (Soldier) and his wife Sophia Chambers (who is sane) and I attended him, and his wife at different times during a number of years and since his death have continued to attend Sophia Chambers (who is still his widow) to the present date.
